



ALTERNATIVE METHOD FOR DETERMINING RAFFLE WINNERS GAME INSTRUCTIONS

(Daily 3 / Daily 4)

BACKGROUND

General Rule 101(1)(f) defines a raffle as: “. . . an event for which raffle tickets are sold and at which a winner or winners are determined either by randomly selecting stubs from all the raffle tickets sold for an event or by an alternative method that is approved in writing by the bureau, and at which a preannounced prize is awarded.”

Raffle Rule 508(1) states: “An alternative method of determining a winner may be used with the prior written approval of the bureau.”

GAME CONCEPT

The Lottery conducts two drawings each day for the Daily 3 and Daily 4 lottery games. Some organizations use these drawings to determine the winners of their raffles. A maximum of 1,000 raffle tickets may be sold for a Daily 3 raffle, and a maximum of 10,000 raffle tickets may be sold for a Daily 4 raffle.

A raffle licensee is approved to conduct a Daily 3 / Daily 4 raffle, provided: (1) the licensee agrees to follow the requirements outlined in these game instructions, and (2) the licensee ensures compliance with the Bingo Act and Charitable Gaming rules.

GAME CONDUCT

1. Raffle tickets shall indicate whether the winner(s) will be determined by the midday or evening drawing.
2. Raffle tickets shall include the following disclaimer: “If the raffle ticket for the daily number has not been sold, a drawing from the pool of raffle ticket stubs for the tickets sold will take place at [specify location] between [(1 p.m. – 1:30 p.m.) or (7:30 p.m. – 8 p.m.)] the same day.”
3. If the raffle ticket with the number that matches the winning Daily 3 / Daily 4 number has not been sold, the winner shall be determined by a traditional raffle drawing on the scheduled date and time.

RESTRICTIONS

4. Use of the terms “lotto” or “lottery” is prohibited on raffle tickets and may not be used in any manner to describe or advertise a raffle.
5. Ticket purchasers may not choose their numbers; all numbers shall be randomly assigned.
6. There shall be no multiple winners on the same combination of numbers.

HOUSE RULES

7. House rules shall be in accordance with Raffle Rule 510 and shall contain all other information essential to a participant's understanding of how the Daily 3 / Daily 4 raffle will be conducted.
8. House rules shall be retained with the game records.
