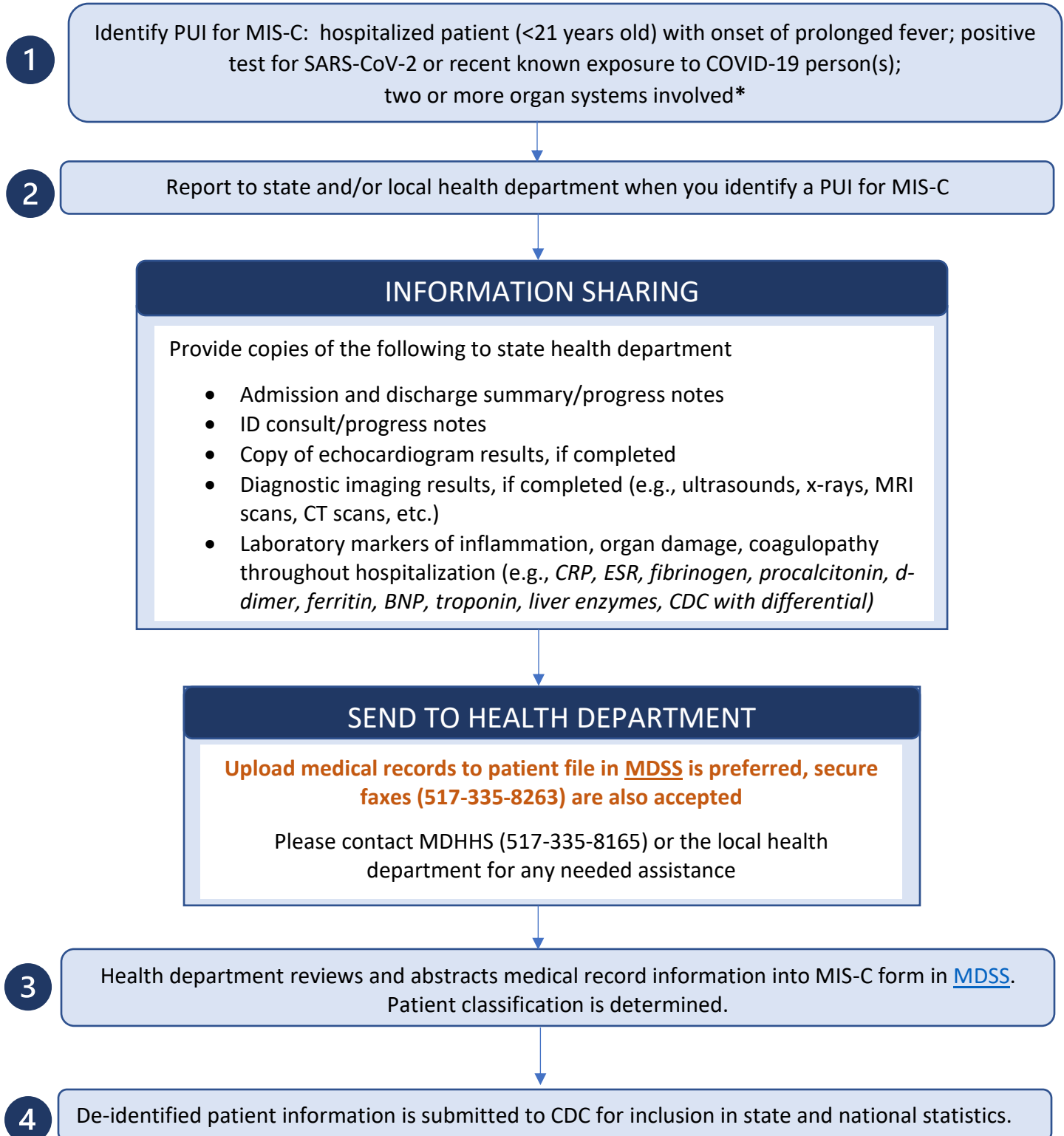


MIS-C Job Aid for Clinicians

A guide for sending information to the health department about a patient under investigation (PUI) for **Multisystem Inflammatory Syndrome in Children (MIS-C)**. MIS-C can be life-threatening and is indicative of previous exposure to someone with COVID-19, or infection with the virus that causes COVID-19. Providers are asked to maintain a high degree of suspicion for MIS-C in pediatric patients (*up to 21 years of age*) presenting with symptoms of Kawasaki Disease or ill individuals who have been previously exposed to COVID-19.
