

REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE
Pursuant to Public Act 107 of 2017
Article V, Section 816
Health Care – Pharmaceutical Expenditures

Sec. 816. By April 1, the department shall provide the members of the senate and house appropriations subcommittees on corrections, the senate and house fiscal agencies, the state budget director, and the legislative corrections ombudsman with a report on pharmaceutical expenditures and prescribing practices. In particular, the report shall provide the following information:

(a) A detailed accounting of expenditures on antipsychotic medications.

Year-to-Date expenditures for antipsychotic medications for October 2017 to February 2018 are \$979,999.52. The monthly breakdown of expenditures is:

October 2017	\$205,240.31
November 2017	\$208,557.06
December 2017	\$175,387.68
January 2018	\$199,953.99
February 2018	\$190,860.48

(b) Any changes that have been made to the prescription drug formularies.

The Michigan Department of Corrections, Bureau of Health Care Services maintains a Clinical Formulary reference book which was first approved on September 20, 2006 and most recently updated on February 28, 2018. The Clinical Formulary has been updated 17 times during the 2017-2018 Fiscal year. These occurred on January 25, 2017, February 22, 2017, March 29, 2017, April 26, 2017, May 12, 2017, June 28, 2017, June 29, 2016, July 15, 2017, July 26, 2017, August 23, 2017, September 13, 2017, September 27, 2017, October 25, 2017, December 13, 2017, December 20, 2017, January 24, 2018, February 28, 2018.
