Updates in Policy to Implement a Public Act

Sec. 222. The department shall report no later than April 1 on each specific policy change made to implement a public act affecting the department that took effect during the prior calendar year to the senate and house appropriations committees, the senate and house subcommittees on corrections, the joint committee on administrative rules, and the senate and house fiscal agencies.

The Michigan Department of Corrections developed new flat supervision fee processes for offenders on parole and probation in 2020 in response to the passage of Public Acts 164 and 165 of 2019. The MDOC issued a new version of Policy Directive 06.02.110 “Supervision Fees” and associated Operating Procedure and staff memos. These policies were changed to reflect the \$30/\$60 structure included in the public act, while also clarifying the process for sending unpaid supervision fees to collections.
