

REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE
Pursuant to Public Act 87 of 2021
Article 2, Section 802(2)
Health Care – Pharmaceutical Expenditures

Sec. 802(2). By April 1, the department shall provide the senate and house appropriations subcommittees on corrections, the senate and house fiscal agencies, the legislative corrections ombudsman, and the state budget office with a report on pharmaceutical prescribing practices, including a detailed accounting of expenditures on antipsychotic medications, and any changes that have been made to the prescription drug formularies.

Detailed Accounting of Expenditures on Antipsychotic Medications

Year-to-Date expenditures for antipsychotic medications for October 2021 to February 2022 are \$796,813.20. The monthly breakdown of expenditures is:

October 2021	\$160,115.23
November 2021	\$155,893.15
December 2021	\$152,213.86
January 2022	\$164,800.16
February 2022	\$163,790.80

Fiscal Year 2021 (October 2020-September 2021) antipsychotic medication expenditures totaled \$1,476,473.93

Changes Made to the Prescription Drug Formularies

The Michigan Department of Corrections, Bureau of Health Care Services maintains a Clinical Formulary reference book which was first approved on September 20, 2006 and most recently updated on February 23, 2022. The Clinical Formulary has been updated 2 times during the 2021-2022 Fiscal year. This occurred on February 23, 2022 and on December 15, 2021.
