

**REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE**

**Pursuant to P.A. 87 of 2021**

**Article V, Section 802(1)**

**Physical and Mental Health Care Expenditure Report – FY22 3rd Quarter**

Sec. 802. As a condition of expenditure of the funds appropriated in part 1, the department shall provide the senate and house appropriations subcommittees on corrections, the senate and house fiscal agencies, the legislative corrections ombudsman, and the state budget office with quarterly reports on physical and mental health care, pharmaceutical services, and durable medical equipment, for prisoners. Reports shall detail quarterly and fiscal year-to-date expenditures itemized by vendor, allocations, status of payments from contractors to vendors, and projected year-end expenditures from accounts. Reports shall include a breakdown of all payments to the integrated care provider and to other providers itemized by physical health care, mental health care, pharmaceutical, and durable medical equipment expenditures.

**Status of Payment from Contractors to Vendors** - The Michigan Department of Corrections (MDOC), Budget and Operations Administration, conducts a monthly financial review of Grand Prairie payments for timeliness and accuracy of claims payment information. The financial review for payment status of claims for paid dates beginning 9/29/2021-5/31/2022 for the contract with Grand Prairie (new Vendor) showed that 91% of received claims were paid within 45 days. Of the 47,786 service claims (excluding lab claims) paid from 9/29/2021-5/31/2022, there were 43,642 vendor claims (complete and with authorization codes) paid within 45 days. There were 4,144 vendor claims (or 9%) paid after 45 days. Claims for paid dates beginning 6/1/2021-2/28/2022 for the contract with Corizon (previous Vendor) showed that 80% of received claims were paid within 45 days. Of the 46,650 service claims (excluding lab claims) paid from 6/1/2021-2/28/2022, there were 37,363 vendor claims (complete and with authorization codes) paid within 45 days. There were 9,287 vendor claims (or 20%) paid after 45 days. Monthly reports are received by the MDOC detailing the status of all claims.
