

REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE
Pursuant to P.A. 119 of 2023
Article 2, Section 607
MAT Clinics
FY24 – 4th Quarter

Sec. 607. (2) The department must submit quarterly reports on the status of establishment and operation of medication assisted treatment clinics. Reports shall include, but not be limited to, all of the following: (a) Site locations selected.

(b) Staffing levels.

(c) Expenditures on staffing and supplies, including oral and injectable medications.

(d) Number of prisoners treated.

(e) Number of prisoners requiring treatment but not yet receiving treatment.

Michigan Department of Corrections has 26 correctional facilities prescribing naltrexone and 13 of those correctional facilities are currently prescribing buprenorphine products for Medications for Assisted Treatment (MAT) for those diagnosed with an Opioid Use Disorder. For FY 2024 we have fully implemented at those 3 additional facilities going from 10 facilities to 13 facilities offering buprenorphine. The information below is for the fourth quarter of FY24 and will be updated on a special updated report that will be sent in once all expenses for September have been invoiced.
