Pursuant to P.A. 119 of 2023
Article 2, Section 603
Prisoner Health Care Utilization - FY 2023

Sec. 603. From the funds appropriated in part 1, the department shall provide a report by April 1 on prisoner health care utilization that includes the number of inpatient hospital days, outpatient visits, emergency room visits, and prisoners receiving off-site inpatient medical care in the fiscal year, by facility, and a listing of the 10 most common chronic care conditions.
