

**REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE**  
**Pursuant to P.A. 121 of 2024**  
**Section 607**  
**FY 2025 Quarter 1**  
**Michigan Department of Corrections**

*Sec. 607. (2) The department must submit quarterly reports on the status of establishment and operation of medication-assisted treatment clinics. A report under this subsection must include but not be limited to all of the following:*

*(a) Clinic site locations*

*(b) Staffing levels.*

*(c) Expenditures on staffing and supplies, including oral and injectable medications.*

*(d) Number of prisoners treated.*

*(e) Number of prisoners requiring treatment but not yet receiving treatment.*

Michigan Department of Corrections has 26 correctional facilities prescribing naltrexone and 15 of those correctional facilities are currently prescribing buprenorphine products for Medications for Assisted Treatment (MAT) for those diagnosed with an Opioid Use Disorder. In the first quarter of FY25 we have maintained the 13 fully implemented correctional facilities from FY24 along with fully implementing at 2 additional correctional facilities.

The clinic site locations are Bellamy Creek Correctional Facility – Ionia, Carson City Correctional Facility– Carson City, Central Michigan Correctional Facility– St. Louis, Charles E. Egeler Facility – Jackson, G. Robert Cotton Correctional Facility – Jackson, Gus Harrison Correctional Facility – Adrian, Ionia Correctional Facility – Ionia, Macomb Correctional Facility – New Haven, Marquette Branch Prison – Marquette, Parnall Correctional Facility – Jackson, Richard A. Handlon Correctional Facility – Ionia, St. Louis Correctional Facility – St. Louis, Women's Huron Valley Correctional Complex – Ypsilanti, and Woodland Correctional Facility – Whitmore Lake.

The information below is for the first quarter for FY25 and will be updated on the second quarter report as we have not received all the expenses for December due to pending invoices.
