Pursuant to P.A. 121 of 2024
Article 2, Section 713
Visitor Restriction Report

Sec. 713. From the funds appropriated in part 1, the department must submit a report on the number of prisoners who lost visiting privileges. The report required under this section must be submitted not later than November 15 and include data for the previous fiscal year. The report must include all of the following information:

(a) The number of prisoners who lost visiting privileges by race and by violation type.

Substance Abuse:	1633
Class I Misconduct Associated with a Visit:	97
Escape or Attempted Escape:	0
Felony/Misdemeanor:	0

This boilerplate section became effective on October 1, 2024, but relates to departmental activities prior to that date. The MDOC's system in FY'24 did not track the race of prisoners who lost their visitation privileges. This data will be tracked moving forward in response to this new boilerplate requirement.

(b) The number of cumulative days visitation rights were lost since the start of the fiscal year.

This boilerplate section became effective on October 1, 2024, but relates to departmental activities prior to that date. The MDOC's system in FY'24 did not track the cumulative days that visitation rights were lost. This data will be tracked moving forward in response to this new boilerplate requirement.
