The MDOC is asking for your participation in a 60-Day Wellness Challenge

The Michigan Department of Corrections Wellness Unit and MDOC Employee Engagement Committee recognize the mental toll the last 16 months have been on MDOC employees. While trying to survive through the COVID-19 pandemic, many have lost focus on their wellness. In an effort to help kickstart our journey out of survival mode, the MDOC is encouraging its staff to participate in a 60-Day Wellness Challenge.

"In the last year and a half there isn't one person who hasn't been negatively impacted in some way [by the pandemic]," said Wellness Manager Lynn Gorski. "It is important for us to continue to stay healthy and positive to get to the light at the end of the tunnel."

Make the Commitment

The Wellness Unit has developed a multi-faceted, 60-Day Wellness Challenge to facilitate making wellness a priority in the daily lives of the department and community. From August 16 to October 15 the Wellness Unit is asking you to make the commitment to your wellness as we recover from the pandemic. To participate in the challenge MDOC staff will voluntarily pledge to make wellness a priority for their families, colleagues and themselves by being intentional, steady, kind and courageous. This challenge gives participants the freedom to discover what wellness is for them and execute it for 60-days. Examples include:

- Increasing water intake
- 10 minutes of mindful meditation
- Taking a Walk
- Calling a friend
- Opening a Savings account
- Listening to Music on the way to work

This challenge may look different for everyone, but the key is to stay steady in your wellness direction, don't quit.



How it works

This challenge gives participants the freedom to discover and execute their own wellness goals, however, each worksite will create its own challenge to engage and encourage 60-days of wellness at the workplace. A designated leader at each worksite will be responsible for developing the creative energy and providing resources for staff to successfully complete the challenge. To measure the success of this challenge, the Wellness Unit asks that everyone who makes the commitment take a five-question anonymous pre-and post-survey. For completing the challenge and the surveys, the department will award participants with a "Make the Wellness Commitment" Challenge Coin to celebrate and acknowledge their commitment to wellness. The best part, the "Make the Wellness Commitment" Challenge Coin will be designed by a fellow MDOC participant. We are also asking challenge participants to get creative and submit challenge coin designs to be voted on by the department. The winning design will be depicted on the 2021 Wellness Challenge Coin. Designs can be submitted to the MDOC Wellness Unit email at MDOC-Wellness@michigan.gov and must be submitted by September 15. During the next few weeks, more information will be shared on how you can take the survey and participate in this challenge

How to be Successful in this Challenge

Having a partner or team is helpful to share your wellness journey with. Ask your colleagues what they are doing for wellness. During staff meetings, share what you are doing and what progress you have made toward your wellness. Start intentional conversations about your wellness and be encouraging of other's wellness journey. Show appreciation and thoughtful-

ness to yourself and others. Saying things like, "I am thinking of you," "thank you," or "you're making a difference." The most important thing you can do for your wellness is to stay committed to it. Don't quit. Set out time every day to dedicate to wellness.

"It's not about failing, it's about not quitting and continuing to make strides in your wellness," said Gorski. "Stay the course and encourage others to stay the course as well."

Collins is excited for her new role at the MDOC and knows that the work done within the MDOC will have a significant impact on the SOM workforce. MDOC employees should contact Collins with any Executive Directive 2019-09: Equal Opportunity in State Employment, State Contracting and Grant and Loan Program or Executive Directive 2019-10: Equal Pay for Equal Work complaints. Staff can also contact Collins with any comments, concerns, or questions about the DEI work culture. Collins hopes to serve the MDOC in a way that is much bigger than compliance.

"I envision my role as one in which people can discuss DEI issues with me in a way that will bring about organizational change and highlight any training and professional development needs," said Collins. "I feel to create and operationalize organizational change, people should feel comfortable contacting me not only in a formal compliance capacity but also in an informal way."

Collins knows from experience that there will be MDOC staff who may be able to identify an area of DEI and work culture that needs improvement, but that doesn't necessarily rise to the level of a complaint. Collins explains that there is no DEI problem too big or too small for someone to bring to her, even the smallest of changes can have a large impact on the organization. If she is not the right person to address the issue, she will work to ensure people are connected to the right individuals.

"I feel lucky and grateful to be with the people in my platoon," said Officer Leone. "Everyone brought something to the table."


Officer Leone suggests new recruits do their research and make sure they've listed out the pros and cons of the job before applying. She says it is important that you are willing to put in the commitment and effort.

MDOC RECIDIVISM RATE RANKS SIXTH IN THE NATION

Each year the Virginia Department of Corrections publishes a report on national recidivism rates, which measures the percentage of prisoners who return to prison within three years of release. This year the MDOC has achieved its highest ranking to date, ranking in sixth place nationally. Michigan's recidivism rate is currently at 26.6% dropping from 26.7% in 2020 and 29.1% in 2019.

This ranking is a testament to all the hard work of our staff who have remained committed to offender success. You continue to make a difference in the lives of those we serve and our communities.

The Extra Mile MDOC staff go beyond the call of duty to help others



Parnall Correctional Facility Corrections Officer Tom Spence received the MDOC Lifesaving Award. He was on duty in food service in October of 2019 when a prisoner began choking. Officer Spence administered abdominal thrusts to the prisoner. He was able to clear the prisoner's airway, and the inmate began responding. His quick response and use of MDOC training helped save the prisoner's life.

Charles Egeler Reception and Guidance Center Corrections Officer Adam Schell received the department's lifesaving award. Officer Schell was at Henry Ford Allegiance Hospital when a woman who was there for some health-related tests began struggling to breathe. Officer Schell immediately stepped in and performed CPR. We commend him on his quick, lifesaving action, and join the team at RGC in congratulating him on this well-deserved recognition.





In November 2019, Agent Carol George received a call from an FTO who was on a call with a parolee on her caseload. The parolee advised he was in a garage with the car running but did not provide a location. Agent George called 911 and informed the Oakland County Sheriff's Department that the parolee appeared to be suicidal and provided them with three possible addresses as to where he might be. When the Sheriff Deputies arrived at the parolee's address they found him unconscious. The parolee was transported to McLaren Hospital where he was found to have carbon dioxide poisoning as well as alcohol and drugs in his system. Oakland County Sheriff Deputies indicated if they would have arrived five minutes later the parolee would have died from his attempted suicide. Agent George's display of professional integrity in a stressful situation earned her the department's Lifesaving Award.

The Extra Mile continued...

In 2018, while Carson City Correctional Facility Corrections Officer Rolando Cantu was working in Housing Unit 800, he responded to a prisoner assaulting a staff member incident. Officer Cantu single-handedly subdued the prisoner while instructing co-workers to direct other prisoners to their cells and shut the housing unit down. Officer Cantu's co-worker received significant injuries, but Officer Cantu's immediate response prevented further harm and stopped a very serious incident from escalating further.

Also in 2018, Officer Cantu was driving to work one morning when he noticed skid marks in the road and what appeared to be headlights in a ditch. Officer Cantu stopped and found two individuals trapped inside a vehicle. He immediately dialed 911 and, after confirming the individuals were both alert, assisted them out of the vehicle through a partially opened window out of concern for a possible gas leak. Officer Cantu's ability to respond quickly and appropriately in such stressful situations earned him the department's Lifesaving Award and Citizenship Award.

In August 2018, while driving on Michigan Avenue in Detroit, Agent Brianne McGill observed a citizen on the ground who was bluish in color. It appeared someone was attempting to administer CPR; however, they were sitting on top of the citizen. Agent McGill immediately stopped her vehicle and ran to assist. She was able to convince the person attempting to administer CPR to get off the person in distress so chest compressions could begin. Soon after, EMS arrived and after administering Narcan, they were able to revive the person. Agent McGill's quick thinking earned her the department's Lifesaving Award.

Departmental Technician Ena Busby received a lifesaving award for staying on the telephone with an intoxicated parolee who was threatening to commit suicide. Busby was able to calm the parolee and prompted him to go to the hospital where he received mental health treatment. Busby's swift thinking and prompt action earned her the department's Lifesaving Award.
