



Corrections Connection Second Quarter 2022



Prisoners receive a second chance through education.

Smiles can be seen from across the gymnasium as graduates file in one by one. Family, standing, taking pictures and waving as their graduate walks to take their seat. An overwhelming sense of pride can be seen in both the graduates and their families' eyes as

the graduates prepare to walk across the stage to collect their diplomas. This is just like any other graduation, except this graduation is in a prison. The Michigan Department of Corrections is the largest provider of basic adult education in the state. And through partnerships with multiple accredited post-secondary education institutions, the MDOC is also able to provide prisoners with the opportunity to earn college degrees or certificates. Their accomplishments were celebrated at graduation ceremonies at facilities across the state over the past few months. Eligible prisoners take face-to-face college classes in the prisons. Instructors at the college institution come to the prisons to instruct the students, giving them a similar experience to a traditional college course outside of the prison.

The Department's goal in providing prisoners with post-secondary educational opportunities is to reduce recidivism and improve the employability of people returning to communities after incarceration. Statistically, those who attend college while incarcerated are less likely to return to prison and even though serving life, they can serve as role models and mentors in their facilities.

Previously prisoners and their families would have to pay out of pocket to take college courses while in prison. However, these educational opportunities are made possible for many prisoners through Federal Second Chance Pell Grants. Of the 492 prisoners currently enrolled in post-secondary education at the MDOC, 455 are Pell awarded students and 37 are self-pay students. The MDOC is currently partnered with six post-secondary educational institutions and looks forward to partnering with more as the Pell


Grant program expands.

The MDOC also provides education to prisoners through our three Vocational Villages at Parnall Correctional Facility, Richard A. Handlon Correctional Facility and Women's Huron Valley Correctional Facility. The Vocational Village provides prisoners with hands-on technical training in a variety of fields including, auto mechanics, carpentry, CNC machining, electrical, plumbing, welding, forklift, robotics, truck driving, masonry, line clearance/tree trimming, computer coding, food technology, and diesel mechanics. The newest Vocational Village at Women's Huron Valley Correctional Facility provides training in carpentry, robotics, cosmetology, 3D printing, truck driving, food technology, forklift and horticulture. Prisoners receive both state and nationally recognized certificates upon completion of their training. Vocational Village students participate in facility job fairs and can be interviewed by employers prior to release.

Education is one of the best ways to reduce recidivism and the MDOC is proud of the work being done to provide prisoners with post-secondary education. Receiving a degree is a huge accomplishment for anyone, however, residing in a prison can make getting a degree all the more difficult. With that said, many prisoners persevere and strive to get the most out of their education often receiving high honors, making this accomplishment all the more special. For many prisoners, they are the first in their families



to receive a degree. The joy, laughter and tears seen as families watch their loved ones graduate is a testimony of the impact education can have. Through education, prisoners now have a second chance to make a difference in their facilities and in their communities.











Fiscal Year 2023 Budget

The final version of the Fiscal Year 2023 budget has been passed by the Legislature and is awaiting final approval by the Governor. The Department's executive leadership has spent the last 4 months working with our legislative partners to address the MDOC's short and long-term investment needs, resulting in a budget that makes historic investments in staff, technology, and our facilities.

Highlights of the Fiscal Year 2023 budget include \$42 million in employee economic increases to support previously negotiated 5% staff raises that take effect on October 1, \$2.5 million in one-time investments to improve staff areas at correctional facilities, particularly staff breakrooms and bathrooms, and an additional \$2.5 million to support the expansion of Vocational Village programming. The budget also provides \$500,000 for new corrections officer polo shirts that have received positive staff feedback after being piloted at select worksites as an alternative uniform.

The MDOC's initial budget recommendation was comprised of several transformative technology investments to support staff and increase the educational opportunities for prisoners. We are pleased that the final budget provides significant investments in technology for facilities, including \$15 million to start the installation of secure Wi-Fi networks, \$4.5 million to deploy body

scanners to all remaining facilities to detect prisoner contraband, and \$1 million to complete installation of a Page Alert System for Deaf and Hard of Hearing prisoners that will simplify staff communications with this population. To support the Department's new technology and research efforts, the budget also provides funding to increase our research staff and capabilities.

While this budget includes more new funding initiatives than recent past budgets, it also maintains all key ongoing expenditures. This includes sufficient funding to recruit and train 800 corrections officers in the upcoming fiscal year to reduce vacancies, support for prisoner programming and education, as well as field operations and community-based services and supports. These important goals were achieved while also removing the prisoner phone contract as a source of revenue to support programming, resulting in \$11 million in savings for prisoners and their families.

The negotiated budget is a clear sign of the Department's commitment to supporting our staff and operations, while making strategic investments in technology that will support our future efforts. We are pleased with the support we have received from Governor Whitmer and the State Budget Office during this process and look forward to implementing the final budget October 1.

We are grateful to serve such a generous and supportive community.






MDOC WELCOMES NEW FIELD AGENTS AND INSTITUTIONAL PAROLE AGENTS

CORRECTIONS OFFENDER MANAGEMENT SYSTEM



The MDOC COMS Project team is preparing training for the Field Operations and Parole Board (FO/PB) Case Management module of Corrections Offender Management System (COMS). The goal of this training is to give staff the skills they need to navigate and start using COMS with confidence. Staff training will take place between July 18 and September 2. Staff will sign-up for training through the State of Michigan Learning Center (SOMLC) and will receive training using Microsoft Teams. Prior to their training sessions, staff will receive a copy of the appropriate training manual, agenda, COMS Case Management Usability Tips Sheet, and a sample attachment which will be used during training. Staff will get handson experience in a training environment to prepare for the daily tasks they will complete in COMS. Once training is complete, recordings of the training session will be available on the COMS Project website.
