Vocational Village students receive both state and nationally-recognized certificates. Certificates from the State of Michigan stating which specific tasks are completed and the number of hours trained for the class.

# Know the facts!

## KEY POINTS

- Located at the Women's Huron Valley Correctional Facility in Ypsilanti, this Vocational Village site is the first of its kind for women.
- The program at the women's facility offers training in high-demand trades: carpentry, cosmetology, 3D printing, robotics, truck driving, food technology and horticulture. Training in forklift operation is also offered as a stackable credential.
- It is the 3rd Vocational Village site in the state. A Vocational Village site opened at Richard A. Handlon Correctional Facility in Ionia in 2016 and at Parnall Correctional Facility in Jackson in 2017.
- Qualified students will receive a Certificate of Employability, which assists them in obtaining quality employment post-release.
- All Vocational Villagers are required to complete an employment readiness course that prepares them to enter the workforce.
- Eligible students who pass the ACT WorkKeys test will receive nationally recognized Career Readiness Certificates.
- Vocational Village students participate in facility job fairs and can be interviewed by employers prior to release.
