AUTHORITY

Public Act 511 of 1988

SUBJECT

Award of Funds

POLICY

No funds shall be awarded to local jurisdictions that have not had their Comprehensive Corrections Plan approved by the local community corrections advisory board and the local governing authority. Awards shall be officially reviewed by the state community corrections board and approved by the Director of the department.

CCABs may be awarded multi-year contracts up to three (3) years provided that they have a successful MDOC review within the previous contract period.

Counties that do not qualify for a multi-year contract shall submit their Comprehensive Corrections Plans annually. Counties who have had a successful MDOC review within the previous contract period may also elect to submit their Comprehensive Corrections Plan annually.

RULE:

Definitions

Comprehensive Corrections Plan: Also referred to as “Comprehensive Plan,” this is the detailed, local CCAB plan that identifies how prison commitment rates (PCRs), recidivism, and State Board Priorities will be impacted through the use of P.A. 511 funded, evidence-based programming and services. The plan identifies local key objectives and performance outcomes and measures, supported by dispositional and recidivism data analyses, as well as local impact analysis and supportive budget documents

Successful MDOC Review: The Contractor shall meet the contractual obligations noted on the MDOC Review, completed by the Department. Every three years, the Department will conduct this evaluation, and a percentage of compliance will be noted. At a minimum, eighty percent (80%) compliance is required for a successful review.

ANNUAL CONTRACTS

Who

Does What

CCAB

Completes and approves the local Comprehensive Corrections Plan and submits to local governing authority for approval.

CCAB Manager

Upon approval submits Comprehensive Corrections Plan to assigned Community Corrections Specialist.

OCC Manager

Sends proposals (CFJ 259) and funding award recommendations to the Michigan Community Corrections Board.

State Board

Review proposals (CFJ 259) and make funding award recommendations to the Director through a vote at a State Community Corrections Board meeting.

MULTI-YEAR CONTRACTS

CCAB

For the first year of a multi-year contract, completes and approves the local Comprehensive Corrections Plan and submits to local governing authority for approval.

For subsequent years, completes and approves Part One and budget documents of the local Comprehensive Corrections Plan annually and submits to local governing authority for approval.

CCAB Manager

Upon approval submits Comprehensive Corrections Plan and/or Part One and budget documents of the local Comprehensive Corrections Plan to assigned Community Corrections Specialist.

OCC Manager

Sends proposals (CFJ 259) and funding award recommendations to the Michigan Community Corrections Board.

State Board

Review proposals (CFJ 259) and make funding award recommendations to the Director through a vote at a State Community Corrections Board meeting. Funding recommendations for multi-year contracts shall be the same amount each year of the contract. The funding actually awarded in any year shall be subject to available appropriations.
