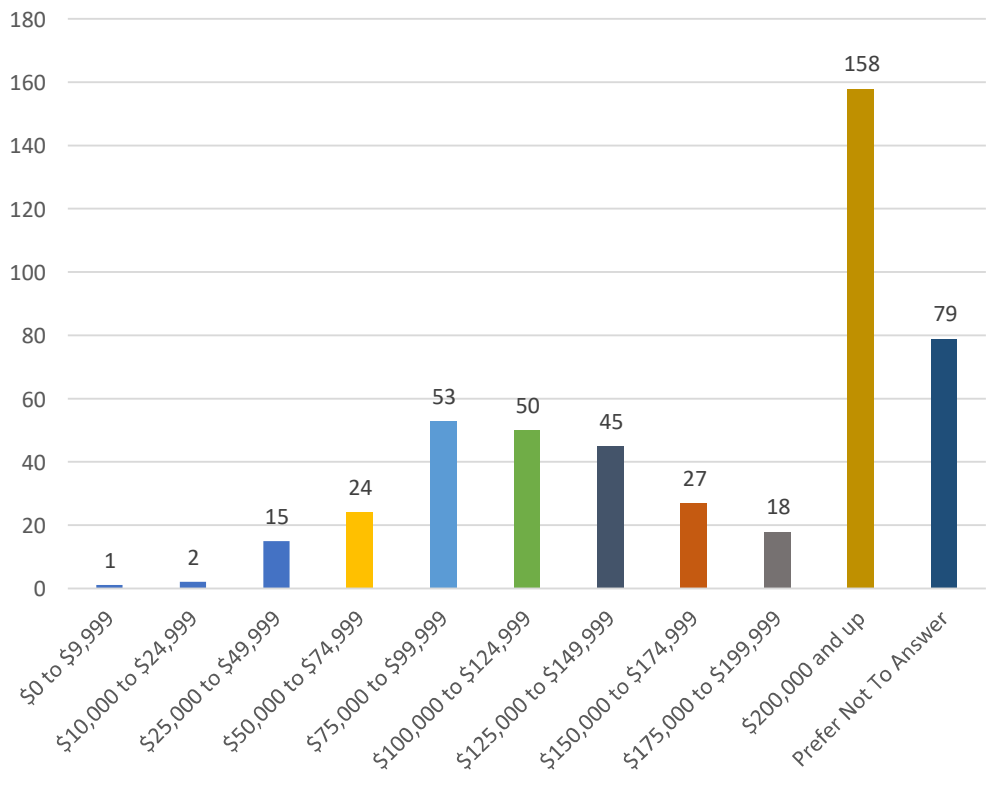


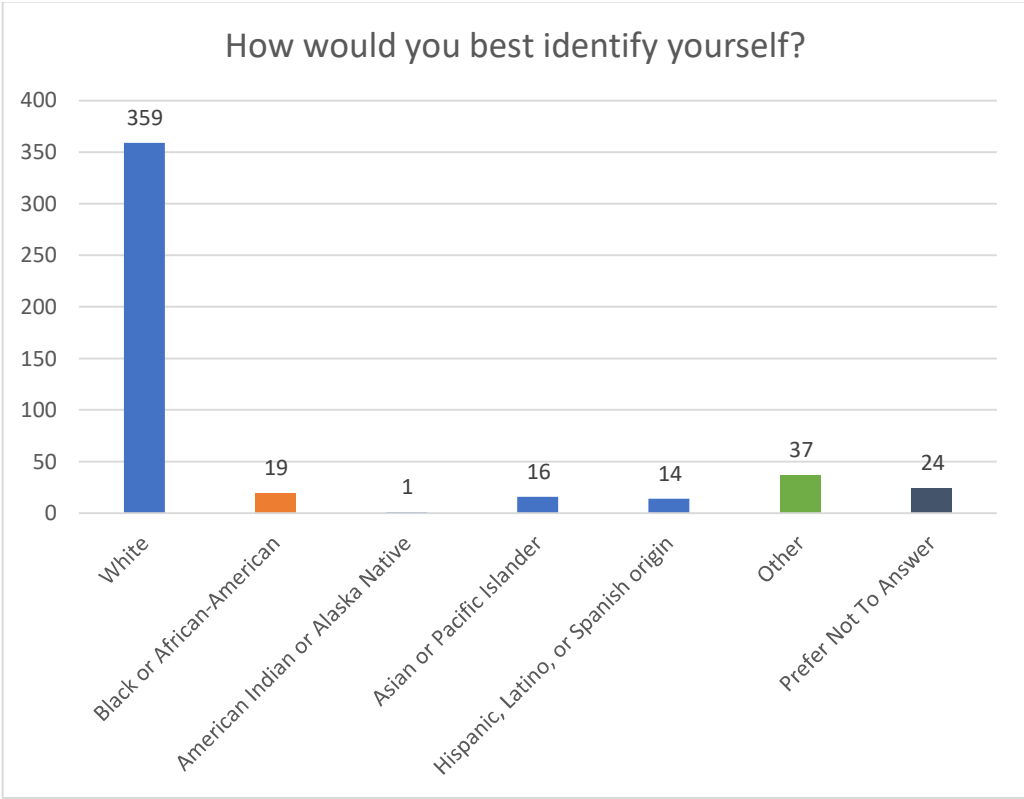


### What is the highest level of education you have completed?

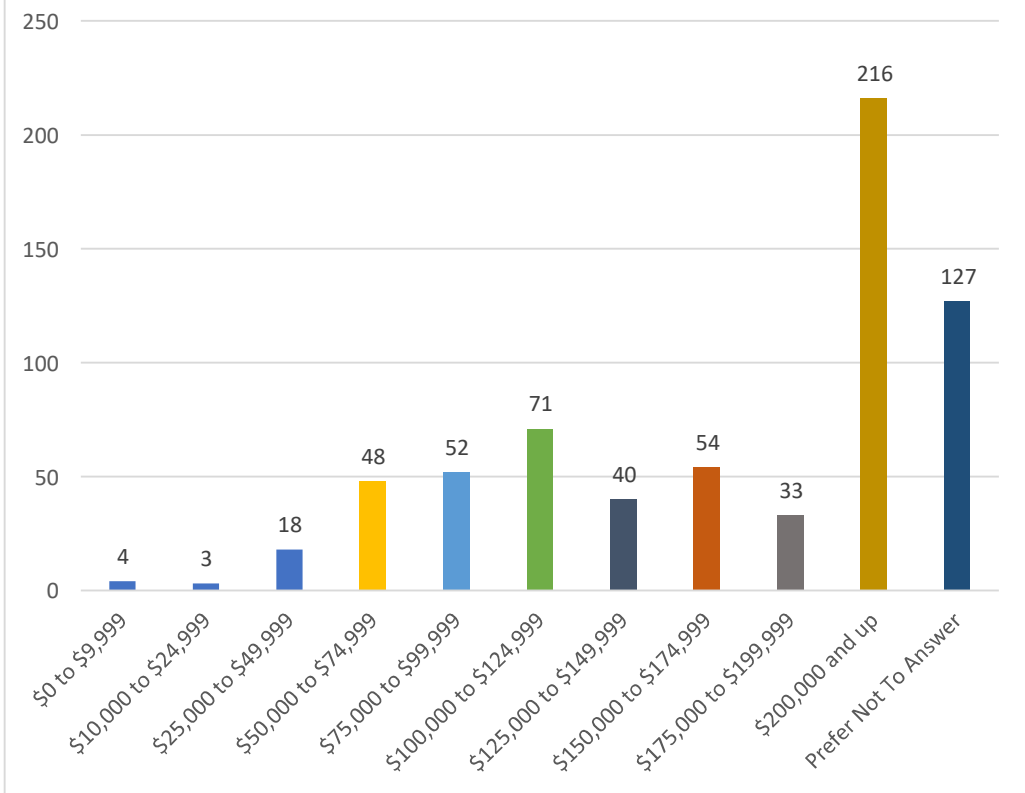


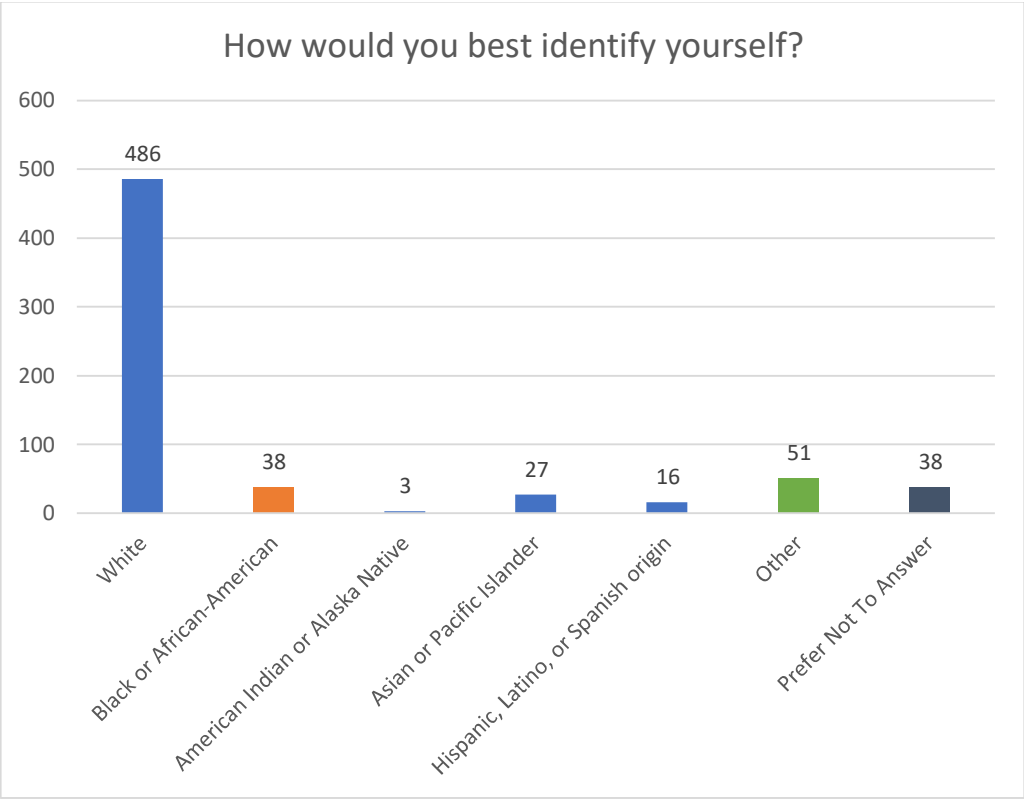


### What is the highest level of education you have completed?
