CONSENT ORDER

On April 3, 2024, the Cannabis Regulatory Agency (CRA) issued a formal complaint against the adult use class C marijuana grower license (no. AU-G-C-000925) of Cherry Industries, LLC (Respondent) under the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act (MRTMA), MCL 333.27951 *et seq.*, and administrative rules promulgated thereunder. The complaint alleged Respondent violated Mich Admin Code, R 420.102(1)(c), R 420.102(7), R 420.206(4), R 420.209(11), R 420.209(12), R 420.210(1), R 420.210(2), R 420.212(1), R 420.303(1), R 420.303(2), R 420.303(4), R 420.303(5), R 420.304(2)(c), R 420.304(2)(f), R 420.305(11) and R 420.602(5).

The executive director or designee reviewed the stipulation contained in this document and agrees the public interest is best served by resolution of the complaint. Therefore, the executive director or designee finds that the allegations contained in the complaint are true and that Respondent violated Mich Admin Code, R 420.102(1)(c), R 420.102(7), R 420.206(4), R 420.209(11), R 420.209(12), R 420.210(1), R 420.210(2), R 420.212(1), R 420.303(1), R 420.303(2), R 420.303(4), R 420.303(5), R 420.304(2)(c), R 420.304(2)(f), R 420.305(11) and R 420.602(5).

Accordingly, for these violations, IT IS ORDERED:

1. Respondent's license (no. AU-G-C-000925) is permanently surrendered 10 days after the effective date of this order. The license shall not be renewed, reinstated, reissued, or reactivated, limited or otherwise, at any future date.

2. Respondent shall complete the relevant procedures for closing a licensed marijuana business found at <https://www.michigan.gov/cra/closing-a-licensed-marijuana-business/technical-steps-to-close-a-license-with-the-cra>.

This order shall be effective on the date signed by the CRA's executive director or designee, as set forth below.

STIPULATION

The parties stipulate to the following:

1. The facts alleged in the formal complaint are true and constitute a violation of the administrative rules promulgated under the MRTMA.

2. Respondent understands and intends that by signing this stipulation, Respondent is waiving the right under the MRMTA, administrative rules promulgated thereunder, and the Administrative Procedures Act of 1969, MCL 24.201 *et seq.*, to require the CRA to prove the charges set forth in the complaint by presentation of evidence and legal authority and to present a defense to the charges.

3. The parties considered the following in reaching this agreement:
 - a. Respondent is voluntarily surrendering license no. AU-G-C-000925 and understands and agrees that any renewal application submitted for this license will be denied.
 - b. Respondent was cooperative and wishes to resolve the allegations without the need for and expense of an administrative hearing.


4. The CRA’s Legal Division director or designee must approve this proposed agreement before it is forwarded to the CRA’s executive director or designee for review and issuance of the above consent order. The parties reserve the right to proceed to an administrative hearing without prejudice to either party, should the CRA’s Legal Division director, executive director, or designees reject the proposed consent order.

By signing this stipulation, the parties confirm that they have read, understand, and agree with the terms of the consent order.
