SOCIAL EQUITY PLAN

Granny Farm is a family-owned business with a strong focus on community engagement and social impact. We are socially involved in community collaborations and aims to address the disproportionate impact of marijuana prohibition and enforcement on our neighborhood.

The goals and objectives of Granny Farm are aligned with the CRA and will definitely complement the social equity program, as we continue employing citizens who have been directly impacted. Giving back is a key hallmark of Granny Farm and some of our efforts will include:

Educational Programs:

- Host workshops and educational sessions to inform the community about the impact of marijuana prohibition and enforcement.
- Provide resources and proven information on the positive effects marijuana has on some medical conditions.

Employment Opportunity and Job Training:

- We will hire at least 50% of our employees from the communities that have been negatively impacted.
- We will implement a comprehensive employee benefits package to include life and health insurance, retirement and a vacation package to all full time employees.

- We will create a program that offers job training and mentoring to individuals expressing in interest in the marijuana industry.
- We will provide information, resources and assistance on expungement of marijuana-related convictions for interested residents.

Community Events/Gatherings/Social

- Establish an agricultural partnership with a local agricultural company such as Green of Detroit to assist with education on gardening and provide resources.
- Collaborate with Gleaners Community Food Bank or Forgotten Harvest, along with community organization to host at one food bank per year.
- Host a Thanksgiving Turkey Drive for residences in the community.
- We will continue hosting at least two community clean ups, providing gloves, bags and use of lawn equipment.
- We will create an Adopt-A-Family Program, adopting at least one family from the community at Christmas.

Collaboration With Local Businesses:

- Foster collaborations with other local business to create a network of support within the community including Back-To-School items.
 - Joint initiatives and partnerships to amplify the impact of our community-oriented programs.
 - Participate in community block clubs and 11th precinct monthly meetings.
