Community Partners

In every community in which Leaf and Bud operates, they partner with a local community-based nonprofit in order to provide volunteer and financial support. Our goal is to increase person hours each year over the previous calendar year.

Capacity Building for emerging Cannabis Companies

In order to help build the capacity of underrepresented groups in the cannabis industry, Leaf and Bud will make marijuana products available to Detroit Legacy Applicants and State of Michigan Social Equity applicants at reduced cost. This will help level the playing field for retail businesses that do not have the capital to own and operate a cultivation facility. Retail partnership will be sought with women and minority owned enterprises.

Expungement Programs

Leaf and Bud supports the expungement of criminal records for those Michigan residents unfairly targeted for cannabis crimes that are now legal due to the legalization efforts. Once operating, we will support 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organizations in Detroit, Michigan.

Employment

Leaf and Bud commits to hiring at least 50% of its full-time workforce from the communities that have been disproportionately impacted affected by marijuana convictions. All jobs will pay a living wage and include benefits.
