Social Equity Plan

Plan B Wellness Center, LLC (“**Plan B**”) adopts the following plan to promote and encourage participation in the marijuana industry by people from communities that have been disproportionately impacted by marijuana prohibition and to positively impact those communities. Furthermore, the following plan outlines the efforts Plan B will utilize to support the Social Equity Program administered by the Cannabis Regulatory Agency of the State of Michigan.

General Policy and Procedures

Plan B will utilize educational presentations, mentorship possibilities, employment opportunities, and investing in the local community to promote social equity. In addition, Plan B will establish a policy for maintaining dedication and support to social equity efforts in the community and around Michigan. Finally, Plan B will provide employees with continuing education and resources on the topic of social equity and any recent developments with the CRA’s Social Equity Program.

Educational Presentations

Plan B will facilitate educational presentations for participants who qualify for the Social Equity Program that will feature a wide variety of speakers, including attorneys, accountants, and entrepreneurs who are considered experts in their respective fields of the marijuana industry. Presentations can include topics related to starting a marijuana business, legal basics for marijuana business, and accounting basics for marijuana businesses.

Social Equity Partner Membership and Employment Opportunities

Plan B is committed to supporting the Social Equity Program and has demonstrated this by adding a Social Equity Program participant as a partner to the business. Along with adding a Social Equity Partner to the business, Plan B also aims to create employment opportunities for members of communities who have been disproportionately impacted by marijuana prohibition. To achieve this objective, Plan B will consider whether applicants for employment opportunities have past convictions for marijuana offenses. Finally, Plan B will seek to mentor and give employment opportunities to potential participants of the Social Equity Program and other members of the local community who are interested in entering the marijuana industry.

Community Investment

Located in a community that has been disproportionately affected by marijuana prohibition, Plan B has and will continue to donate in-kind and monetary support to Detroit-based organizations dedicated to serving the public.
