## **Task Force 1620**

### **Program Overview:**

Task Force 1620 is an innovative program designed to increase veteran access to safe and affordable cannabis products within the state of Michigan. This program is a demonstration of our commitment to supporting the health and well-being of veterans in our communities.

### **Nomination Process:**

- CHO will accept nominations for local veterans to be considered for acceptance into the Task Force 1620 program from the general public.
- The nominations will be submitted through a designated platform or via in-store forms for ease of access.
- Nominations will be open for a specified period to allow for ample consideration.

### **Selection Committee:**

- A committee comprised of select, anonymous employees at CHO will review the nominations received from the general public.
- The committee will carefully assess each nomination based on established criteria, ensuring a fair and objective selection process.

### **Participant Selection:**

- The Task Force 1620 committee will make a final decision on which three veterans will be accepted into the program.
- The maximum number of veterans to be accepted to participate at each CHO store location will be three, ensuring personalized attention and support.

### **Program Benefits:**

- Selected veterans will be privileged to receive up to seven dollars' worth of pre-rolls or edibles completely for free each week.
- The 100% discounted cannabis products will be tracked through the participants' customer accounts, with weekly redemptions being notated by CHO.

### **Program Rules and Accountability:**

- Weeks that are missed cannot be reclaimed, promoting consistent participation in the program.
- Not claiming at least one 100% discounted item per month will be grounds for removal from the program, allowing another veteran to be selected by the committee.
