
TASK FORCE 1620 PROGRAM SUMMARY

When Nature's ReLeaf first heard about the concept that became the Task Force 1620 Program we were immediately interested in joining the cause.

Nature's ReLeaf Mancelona participated in the first in-store test run through the early version of the program, donating cannabis products to a veteran named Randy Wakefield on March 16, 2023. Our brand Fuel Cannabis, produced at our farm in Vassar, provided 100% of the products that Randy stated he needed for a month supply in partnership with Light'N Up Cannabis, Redemption Cannabis, and Anton Harb.

We are excited to apply to officially join the Program now that it has launched and look forward to providing cannabis products to our local veterans and bring them relief at no cost. We are honored to have the chance to help Michigan's veteran community in any way we can.

Our initial plan is to identify 3 veterans in each city that we operate and work with them to provide monthly allotments of cannabis products based. In our opinion, the best way to administer the program is going to be listening to each individual and taking the time to understand their condition. If we are successful in finding a total of 9 veterans to assist with a monthly allotment of cannabis products, we would then reassess and consider adding additional participants at each location if it is feasible.
