IndiGrow Veteran Cannabis Access Program (VCAP)

Summary:

Contact information will be required to join the program. Eligibility will be checked on first visit and can be proven with a Veteran endorsed ID, VA card, Military ID, or discharge paperwork. This will not be required on subsequent visits.

2. 75% Discount on Cannabis Products:

Veterans enrolled in the program are eligible for a substantial 75% discount on their monthly allocation of cannabis, specifically up to an 1/8th of flower or 1 pack of 100mg edibles. This discount aims to make marijuana more affordable and accessible to veterans seeking alternative treatments.

3. Quality Assurance:

IndiGrow is committed to providing veterans with high-quality cannabis products. The program ensures that the cannabis supplied meets rigorous quality standards, providing participants with safe and effective options for managing various health conditions.

4. Educational Resources:

VCAP includes educational resources that inform veterans about the potential benefits and risks associated with cannabis use. This includes information on different strains, consumption methods, and responsible usage practices.

5. Community Building:
