Facility Reporting Requirements for Hazardous Materials

According to Section 5p of the Michigan Fire Prevention Code (Act 207), licensed marijuana facilities must provide the following information upon written request by the fire chief within their jurisdiction regarding hazardous chemicals:

- A list of hazardous chemicals on site and a Safety Data Sheet (SDS) for each chemical on the list.
- A description of the quantity and location of any hazardous chemical specified by the fire chief after review of the list.

Licensees must respond within ten working days after receipt of a written request by the fire chief. Upon request, the fire chief may extend the time to provide the information by five working days.

There are three emergency planning requirements that fire departments and/or the communities they serve must meet. These are required to ensure firefighter safety; there are no exemptions based on quantity of chemical at the site:

- Firefighter Right to Know
- Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response
- Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act, Title III
