## MEDICAL MARIHUANA LICENSING BOARD

### RESOLUTION ON APPLICANT REVIEW AND EVALUATION

At a regularly scheduled meeting of the Medical Marihuana Licensing Board (Board), convened in Lansing, Michigan, the following resolution was adopted.

#### WHEREAS:

The Board is established within the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (Department) under the Medical Marihuana Facilities Licensing Act, 2016 PA 281 (Act), with the general responsibility to implement the Act; and

The Board's duties include granting or denying each application for a state operating license within a reasonable time; and

The Board's powers include the authority to investigate applicants for state operating licenses, determine the eligibility for licenses, and grant licenses to applicants in accordance with the Act and the rules; and


Pursuant to Section 402(2) of the Act, an applicant is ineligible to receive a license if any of the circumstances listed in subdivisions (a) through (i) exist; and

Pursuant to Section 402(3) of the Act, in determining whether to grant a license to an applicant, the Board may consider all of the information listed in subdivisions (a) through (i); and

Pursuant to Section 303(1)(k) of the Act, the Board may delegate the execution of any of its powers that are not specifically and exclusively reserved to the board under the Act for the purpose of administering and enforcing the Act and rules.

THEREFORE:

IT IS RESOLVED that to more efficiently and consistently review and evaluate applicant eligibility for licensure, the Board delegates the review and evaluation of applicants' eligibility under Sections 402(2) and (3) of the Act to the Bureau of Marijuana Regulation (BMR). The BMR is to provide a recommendation for each application presented to the Board as to the applicant's eligibility related to the specific criteria under Sections 402(2) and (3) of the Act. The recommendation is not binding on the Board. The Board shall make a determination of an applicant's eligibility for a state operating license.
