FINAL ORDER

1. This matter came before the Michigan Unarmed Combat Commission (“Commission”) on June 14, 2018.
2. The Commission received a Hearing Report under section 45(3) of the Michigan Unarmed Combat Regulatory Act, (“Act”), MCL 338.3645(3), in this matter, and the Commission considered the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in the Corrected Hearing Report of Thomas A. Halick, Administrative Law Judge, dated April 17, 2018.
3. The Hearing Report and Corrected Hearing Report are incorporated by reference.
4. Respondent was found in violation of the Act and/or its associated administrative rules.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the following penalties, authorized by sections 48 and 49 of the Act, MCL 338.3648 and 338.3649, are imposed:


- A. Respondent must pay a FINE in the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars and 00/100 cents (\$10,000.00) plus ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS in the amount of Three Thousand Dollars and 00/100 cents (\$3,000.00) for a total amount of **Thirteen Thousand Dollars and 00/100 cents (\$13,000.00)** to the State of Michigan. The fine and costs must be received by the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (“Department”) by no later than sixty (60) days from the mailing date of this Final Order. Complaint No. 333100 must be clearly indicated on the check or money order, and the payment sent to the Department’s Corporations, Securities & Commercial Licensing Bureau, Final Order Monitoring-Securities & Audit Division, P.O. Box 30018, Lansing, Michigan 48909.

- B. The license held by Respondent under the Act is SUSPENDED for a minimum period of two years or until the fine and costs are paid, whichever is later.
- C. If the fine and costs are not paid on time, Respondent's license will remain SUSPENDED, and the Department will deny any future applications for licensure or renewal submitted by Respondent under the Act, until the fine and costs are paid in full.
- D. At the conclusion of the suspension period and regardless of whether the fine and costs were paid on time, Respondent must successfully petition the Commission to lift the suspension and apply for relicensure.
- E. Respondent must submit in writing to the Department proof of compliance with each and every requirement of this Final Order in a form acceptable to the Department.

This Final Order does not limit the Department, any other agency of the State of Michigan, or any individual from using any lawful method of collecting the fine and costs imposed by this Final Order.

This Final Order is effective on the date mailed.
