**Update to “Hospitals with Indigent Volume Entitled  
to Enhanced Auto Insurance Reimbursement” List**

This bulletin advises interested parties of two changes to the list of hospitals entitled to enhanced reimbursement under MCL 500.3157(4)(a) and MCL 500.3157(5). See Bulletin 2023-19-INS, issued July 26, 2023.

On August 15, 2023, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) advised the Department of Insurance and Financial Services (DIFS) that the data used to calculate the indigent volume percentages in Bulletin 2023-19-INS required updates. DHHS provided the updated data to DIFS on August 21, 2023. The updated percentages resulted in two changes: 1) the removal of Aspirus Keweenaw Hospital (NPI: 1326115569) from the enhanced reimbursement list altogether; and 2) the addition of Michigan BH JV, LLC as a hospital entitled to enhanced reimbursement under MCL 500.3157(5). With respect to these two hospitals, auto insurers are advised that the designations apply to dates of service beginning July 2, 2023, and that some bills may need to be re-processed to reflect the correct reimbursement amount.
