

## Michigan PBM County Classification and Distance Standards

PBM retail pharmacy<sup>1</sup> service areas<sup>2</sup> must be categorized by urban, suburban, and rural geography and must include the applicable ZIP codes (MCL.550.827). See Appendix A and FIS 2390 PBM Network Adequacy Template.

Michigan has 83 counties, classified as either: Rural A, Rural B, Suburban A, Suburban B, or Urban relative to PBM networks. See Appendix A Michigan County Classifications - PBM Networks.

DIFS does not accept service areas that include partial counties.

### Distance Standards and Access Requirements

PBM networks must meet the distance standards and access requirements as set forth in the table below.

<sup>1</sup> “Retail pharmacy” means a pharmacy that dispenses prescription drugs to the public at retail primarily to individuals that reside in close proximity to the pharmacy, typically by face-to-face interaction with the individual or the individual’s caregiver. (MCL 550.819)

<sup>2</sup> “Service area” means:

- A defined geographical area in which covered health services are generally available and readily accessible to enrollees and where health maintenance organizations may market their contracts (MCL 500.3501(h)), and
- That term as defined in section 3501 unless the context requires otherwise (MCL 500.116).
