Michigan National Guard and Air National Guard Grant 2021 - 2022 Guidelines and Application Form

Eligibility criteria:

- You must be admitted to a degree-granting program as an undergraduate or graduate student at Cornerstone University – Professional & Graduate Studies
- You must be a Michigan Resident since July 1, 2020
- You must be a member of the Michigan Army or Air National Guard;
- You must be eligible for the Reserve Benefits under the Montgomery GI Bill (Chapter 106)
- You must maintain satisfactory academic progress at Cornerstone University – Professional & Graduate Studies.

To apply for the National Guard Grant, you must:

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for 2021 - 2022 and send it to the federal processor or complete the FAFSA on the Internet at www.fafsa.ed.gov;
- Complete the attached 2021 - 2022 Cornerstone University Army and Air National Guard Grant Application, have your unit complete their portion, and submit it to the State Education Office-Room 320, 3423 N. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd, Lansing, MI 48906-2934
