

The **Michigan Member Benefits Program** is directly related to retaining quality Soldiers and Airmen and increasing the combat and personnel readiness of the Michigan National Guard. The Member Benefits Program includes Tuition Assistance, Childcare Assistance, and TRICARE Reimbursement for eligible Michigan Guardsmen.

### GENERAL ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the Michigan Member Benefits Program you must be actively drilling (ING and IRR are not eligible) and meet the following criteria:

- Not under MCMJ or UCMJ action
- Not AWOL
- Not under suspension of favorable actions or adverse administrative actions
- Passing Fitness Test within past 12 months (M-Day or 6 months (AGR/FTNGD)
- Passing Height/Weight within past 8 months (M-Day and AGR)

ELIGIBILITY

- Service Member and/or dependent attending a Michigan based institution
- MIARNG Soldiers must have used or been denied Federal Tuition Assistance (FTA)
- Service Member and/or dependent is applying for assistance with their first degree at the requested level
- Must maintain a 2.0 on a 4.0 scale for undergraduate work
- Must maintain a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale for graduate work

ELIGIBILITY

- Service Member (M-Day/DSG) has completed initial entry training
- Service Member (M-Day/DSG) is a single parent or dual military couple drilling simultaneously or if one parent is on active duty outside of the State of Michigan
- Eligible children are 12 years old or younger.

ELIGIBILITY

- Service Member (M-Day/DSG) has completed Initial Entry Training
- Service Member (M-Day/DSG) is uninsured
- Service Member (M-Day/DSG) does not have civilian employer provided insurance, is not eligible for a parent or spouse's insurance plan
- Service Member (M-Day/DSG) does not have any other insurance (i.e. Medicaid)
- Service Member (M-Day/DSG) is enrolled in TRICARE Reserve Select and/or TRICARE Dental

*The TRICARE Reserve Select Reimbursement program is a bridging solution.*

BENEFITS

- \$14,400/year for Associate or Baccalaureate Degrees
- \$6,000/year for Master's, Professional or Doctorate Degrees
- \$6,000/year for Certificate or Training Programs
