Chair Hodges opened the meeting with member Curis and introductions were made.

Parks and Recreation Update, Ron Olson, Chief

Ron Olson said the public will be educated on the boathouse, via Tom Bissett.

Tom Bissett acknowledged Michele Hodges and Bud Denker for their time as leaders with the Belle Isle Park Advisory Committee. Chair Hodges acknowledged Bud Denker, who showed a champion mentality and authentic love for Belle Isle.

Chair Hodges provided a thank you and introduced the interim Executive Director for the Conservancy, Maud Lyon.

General Updates

Park Updates, Tom Bissett and Gail Fitch

Gail Fitch, Park Supervisor, introduced himself and gave a brief background on his career. He continued that they have concluded the janitor interviews and are on the next phase. The fountain has been shut down for the season and is in the process of winterization, as well as the bathrooms, besides the Bus Stop, which will remain heated and open. Portable facilities have been placed at Sunset Point, Woodside, and Oxbow for the use during the winter season.

Infrastructure Update – Tom Bissett, Urban District Supervisor

With use of a PowerPoint presentation, Tom provided updates on the sawmill casino roof, boiler room, the aquarium heating and cooling system, sewer lines, the dome, Flynn pavilion and pavement markings. (Report attached).

Law Update - Tom Bissett, Urban District Supervisor

Tom Bissett gave the law update for Lt. Szyska who said that speed is still an issue and reminded people to take it slow driving through the park.

Belle Isle Conservancy Updates - Ayo Thomas, Belle Isle Conservancy (Update attached)

Ayo shared slides and updates, including the fall/winter facility hours, stakeholder highlights, and other updates.

Chair Hodges took a moment to acknowledge Missy Kinyon, owner and operator of Detroit Outpost, a kayaking business, who is battling a sickness

and is now in hospice. Chair Hodges said Missy is a champion for the kayaking community and Belle Isle.

Public Comment


Stephen Malbouef – He and others are working to organize a 501c3 nonprofit with goals to prevent the further deterioration of the Belle Isle boathouse and restoring it to its original condition, and to allow the DNR to focus on other projects around the island and for the Friends of Detroit Rowing to focus on their programming.

Gerald Hasspacher – He has been working with Belle Isle Park Dark Sky Initiative and has recently been in touch with a staff person from the DNR who was assigned to the project. He would like this on a future agenda. He also addressed the lighting that needs to be 300K or less.

Michael Curis said on behalf of all the members, he thanked Michele for her leadership for the past 10 years. Within a two-year period, attendance at the park has gone from 2 million people to 5 million, which supersedes all events in Detroit combined in a year. He said this is a testament to Michele's dedication to the island.

With no further business the meeting adjourned at 9:49 a.m.





 Barn Door submittals approved





Belle Isle Casino Roof Replacement

Work Underway:

- Footings for masonry mechanical screen wall being poured.
- Boiler room drain lines for equipment under review for replacement options.
- New copper valley's in roof digitally scanned 11/11/2023 to detail clay tile end caps along valleys.

- Sewer line repair is complete.
- Leaking pipes and radiators of existing boiler system addressed.



Belle Isle Aquarium Update

Boiler room roof structural repairs

- Roof was opened up and structural engineer inspection completed.
- Additional structural support required beyond reinforcement initially observed.
- Plywood temporarily placed until beams are repaired. Tongue and grove wood to be replaced.



Roof is under- supported and needs replacement and reinforcement to stabilize roof.

Anna Scripps Whitcomb Conservatory

Boiler room roof structural repairs

- Glass and bar cap installation is 90% complete.
- Dome glass installation to be complete before Thanksgiving.
- DNR has approved for new glass and bar caps for the lower houses (tropical and desert).
- Scaffolding will begin to be removed this year.



Scaffolding will be removed once glass replacement complete.



Flynn Pavilion Window and Carpentry Repair

Work Underway:

- Window framing mock-up reviewed 11/13/2023.
- Window Repair scheduled through December 2023.
- Painting will be complete in Spring 2023, weather permitting.


