Comments: The desired land was approved as surplus land in September 2021

through the State Land Review. It is isolated from other state ownership. The offered land is surrounded by state land on four sides and will consolidate state-owned land while offering increased recreation and

timber and wildlife habitat.

The state will convey mineral rights on the desired land and the applicant

will convey the mineral rights on the offered land.

The desired land was acquired by tax reversion in 1949.

The proposed land exchange was recommended for approval by the

Land Exchange Review Committee on September 15, 2022.

Recommendations:

1. That the exchange be approved, with the state reserving aboriginal antiquities on the desired state-owned land.

- 2. Proceeds from the exchange will be deposited in the Land Exchange Facilitation Fund (LEFF).
- 3. That the offered lands be dedicated as part of the Traverse City Management Unit.


