



Becoming an Outdoors Woman (BOW) SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Every woman deserves the chance to learn more about the outdoors. This scholarship is open to women who are 18-plus and may not otherwise be able to attend one of our weekend programs. The scholarships are awarded based on financial need, as determined by BOW Michigan, and on available funding.

To apply, submit your scholarship application at least six weeks before your selected BOW weekend to DNRBOW@Michigan.gov or by mail. You must also mail a \$100 check, payable to State of MI-DNR, to 525 W. Allegan Street, Lansing, MI 48933 to reserve your spot.

If you are not awarded a scholarship and decide not to pay the remaining balance of the program fee, your \$100 will be refunded after the application deadline.

Everything submitted will be kept confidential, and previous scholarship recipients are not eligible.
