Lantern-Lit Trail

Saturdays, Jan. 14 and 21, 6 to 9 p.m. ET

Saturdays, Feb. 4, 11, 18, 25, 7 to 9 p.m. ET

Meet at the Trail across from the Ski Hill Parking Lot. Enjoy this one-mile loop trail lit by nearly 70 kerosene lanterns. Wear your cross-country skis or snowshoes, or if the snow is packed, your boots.

Beginner Guided Snowshoe Hikes

Meet at the White Tail Parking Lot (across from the ski hill entrance). This beginner snowshoe hike will take you through a beautiful frosty old growth forest to frozen Lake Superior. This is a one-mile loop hike. Snowshoes are available to borrow on a first come, first served basis.

Advanced Guided Snowshoe Hikes

Fridays, Jan. 13 and 20, at 1 p.m. ET

Fridays, Feb. 3, 10, 17, 24, at 1 p.m. ET

Meet at the Snowshoe Barn at the open slope of the ski hill. This advanced snowshoe hike will test your skills and ability on snowshoes in real snow. We will ride the chair lift to the top of the mountain, take in beautiful views and break through deep snow on the way back down. Expect to go up, down and through deep powder for a 3-mile loop hike. Snowshoes are available to borrow on a first come, first served basis.
