Guided Hike to Cloud Peak

Sept. 27, Oct. 8 and Oct. 15 at 9:30 a.m. ET

Meet at Cloud Peak Trailhead about 100 yards past the picnic area on M-107.

Join the Park Interpreter for this 1.5-mile total out and back hike up to the original view of Lake of the Clouds. Along the way we are going to be talking about the beautiful fall colors, and what the animals are up to this time of year.

This is a moderate difficulty hike with a quick 350-foot elevation gain. Sturdy shoes, walking sticks/trekking poles, snacks and water are recommended.
