Explore with our guides the Tobico Lagoon as we look for signs of spring and observe seasonal changes along the trail. This guided walk is about 1-hour covering 1-mile of trail around the lagoon. Binoculars will be available to borrow for the hike as we look for birds that are slowly returning to the Saginaw Bay Area.
