Led by experienced birders from the Audubon Society of Kalamazoo. Focus is on birding fundamentals, extra binoculars available. 1 - 2 hours but stay as long or as little as you can. Program takes place barring extreme weather. All ages and skill levels welcome.

**Discovery Table** Starts June 13, Thursdays 10 am – noon. Explore a new nature topic each week. Program is informal and intended as a brief experience.
