Monthly Beginner Bird Walks First Saturday of the month at 9 a.m.

September 6, October 4, November 1 and December 6

Led by experienced birders from the Audubon Society of Kalamazoo. Focus is on birding fundamentals, extra binoculars always available. Typically, 2 hours but stay as long or as little as you can. Program takes place barring any special events or bad weather. For birders of all ages and skill levels.

Nature Trails Available daily, dawn to dusk

Discover the water, woods and wildlife of Wolf Lake. Dogs are allowed but a six-foot leash and waste cleanup is required.

Feed the Fish Available daily, dawn to dusk

The fish are always hungry! Free cups of fish food are available during regular hours of operation inside the visitor center, compliments of the Friends of Wolf Lake, a 501 (c) 3 non-profit <a href="www.friendsofwolflake.org">www.friendsofwolflake.org</a> The fish food feeder is always on the dock and accepts quarters.
