Fall Arrows Away Archery

Saturday, September 28, and Saturday, October 12 at 11 a.m. and 1 p.m.

This hour-long program is an introduction to archery for those ages 8 and up. All equipment is provided, and no pre-registration is required for fall sessions.

Monthly Beginner Bird Walks First Saturday of the month @ 9 a.m.

September 7, October 5, November 2, and December 7.

Led by experienced birders from the Audubon Society of Kalamazoo. Focus is on birding fundamentals and extra binoculars are available. Typically, 2 hours but stay as long or as little as you can. The program takes place barring bad weather. All ages and skill levels are welcome.

Nature Trails

Nature trails are open daily from dawn to dusk. Dogs are allowed but a six-foot leash and waste cleanup is required.
