



# Guide to spring wildflower hikes at Wolf Lake State Fish Hatchery



**Bloodroot**  
Large white flower wrapped in a large leaf. Stem actually “bleeds” orangeish-red.



**Skunk cabbage**  
Fun, “stinky” plant that actually melts the snow around it so it can sprout first. Then it has broad green leaves.



**Spring beauty**  
Five-petaled, pink and purple flowers with grasslike stems.



**Wild geranium**  
Delicate pink/lavender flowers blooming in deciduous woodlands.



**Trillium**  
Large, white, three-petaled flowers and large leaves.



**Columbine**  
Nodding, reddish flowers with yellow centers.



**Golden alexanders**  
A member of the parsley family with tiny, creamy-yellow flowers.



**Mayapple**  
Large, umbrella-like plants; “female” plants bloom beneath the leaves and produce apple-like fruits.



**Jack-in-the-pulpit**  
Flower hidden in a striped, green and purple canopy.



**Smooth Solomon's seal**  
Alternating leaves with a bunch of star-shaped flowers at the tip.
