This form is the application for personal use fuelwood. After approval and payment, you will receive a Personal Use Fuelwood Permit and Receipt (PR4166). A permit is required to remove timber and must be in your possession when removing fuelwood from State land.

- 1. Complete and sign application.
- 2. Fuelwood Maps are located online at www.michigan.gov/fuelwood and are referenced by County, Township and Range, e.g. Missaukee, T22N, R07W.

- 3. All permits are \$20.
- 4. Make check payable to State of Michigan.
- 5. Return the completed application and check to the DNR office which manages the State Forest land where you wish to collect fuelwood. Addresses and office locations can be found at: www.michigan.gov/fuelwood.
- 6. General Area permits are for dead and downed wood on open State forest land, as shown on the map attached to your permit and may not be available at all locations. If you are interested in something different, contact your local DNR office about a Specific Area permit.
- 7. If approved, your permit will be emailed or mailed to you.

and signed by the Director's authorized representative, it becomes a valid permit.

8. The permit must be attached to be considered a valid permit and must be in your possession when collecting fuelwood.

## Information

- 1. A Personal Use Fuelwood Permit must be obtained before cutting or removing any firewood (except for campfire wood used for personal and immediate use).
- 2. Collection of campfire wood is covered under a camper's State Forest Campground registration or under the dispersed Camp Registration Card (PR 3134).
- 3. Firewood removed under a Fuelwood Permit must be for personal use only and is not to be sold or traded.
- 4. The Fuelwood Permit is limited to one (1) per household per year and is non-transferable.
- 5. A Fuelwood Permit must be in the possession of the Permittee, and the Permittee must be on site when cutting or in the vehicle when transporting.
- 6. The Fuelwood Permit allows for the removal of up to five (5) standard cords of wood within 200' of a road. A standard cord of wood is a pile of wood with dimensions of 4'x 4'x 8'.
- 7. The Fuelwood Permit is issued during the period of April 1st to December 31st and will be good for up to 90 days, but not past December 31st.
