Notes

Survey followed a roving (instantaneous)-access design. Funding was provided by the Federal Aid to Sport Fish Restoration Project F-81, Study 230499. One clerk worked full time to collect angler survey data. Two weekend days and 3 week days were randomly selected for sampling during each week of the survey season. No holidays were sampled. The clerk followed a randomized count and interview schedule. One of two shifts was selected each sample day. Wamplers Lake and Sand Lake was divided into 2 sites: Sand Lake and Wamplers Lake. One site was randomly selected to be sampled each day. Starting location within a section and direction of travel were randomized for both counting and interviewing. Roving (instantaneous) counts of open ice and shanty anglers were made once per day. Survey period for both counts and interviews was January 1 to January 31. Months were estimated separately. Estimates were made for open ice and shanty modes.
