



ALCOHOL PERMIT FOR SHELTER RENTALS

This information is required under authority of Part 5 of Act 451 of 1994, as amended. MCL 324.501-511 and the Rules of Regulation of State Lands, R299.921-R299.932

RULES AND GUIDELINES

- 1. On department managed lands with a prohibition on alcohol (see LUOD 5.2), an alcohol permit will only be issued to the occupant of a reservable department shelter. If the event will expand beyond the shelter an Event Use Permit will be utilized in place of this form.
- 2. The organization/person renting the shelter shall have ultimate responsibility for the actions and conduct of their guests. This permit does not provide for any additional use for which a use permit would be required.
- 3. Persons under the age of 21 shall not be permitted to possess or consume alcoholic beverages. Anyone under the age of 21 found in possession of an alcoholic beverage will be ticketed and subject to prosecution. The Permittee shall be responsible for making sure persons under the age of 21 are neither in possession of nor consuming alcoholic beverages.
- 4. Alcoholic beverages must be kept within 25 feet of the rented shelter and are not permitted in parking lot areas. Any person found outside of the shelter area with an alcoholic beverage may be ticketed and subject to prosecution.
- 5. This permit may be revoked by any of the following: Michigan State Police Officer, Conservation Officer, Park Officer, Park Manager, or Park Supervisor due to a violation of any of the above conditions and/or any other Michigan State Park Rule, Regulation and/or Michigan State Law.
- 6. The sale or furnishing of alcoholic beverages at public events is prohibited unless a special liquor license from the Michigan Liquor Control Commission has been secured as well as the required DNR event use permit (PR4760).
- 7. Permit holder agrees to indemnify and hold the **State of Michigan, their departments, boards, agencies, commissions, officers, and employees** harmless from all liability because of injury to persons or property arising out of the use of alcohol for which this permit is granted.
- 8. The Permittee must submit a valid state ID with the permit request.
- 9. A non-refundable Alcohol Permit fee of \$50 is due upon submission of this form to the appropriate management unit.
