

PA 240 of 2018:	PILT Estimate: \$3,980.00 This parcel is located north of the Mason-Arenac county line and will result in an increase of 320 acres of DNR-managed lands.

Management Purpose:	The subject property will be managed as part of the Pigeon River Country State Forest.
Comments:	The applicant is offering 320 acres of land that contains the entirety of Doe Lake, a sinkhole lake. This property provides enhanced access for recreational activities and helps protect contiguous forest, riparian areas and wildlife habitat. The land is encumbered by a conservation easement held by Little Traverse Conservancy Conservation Trust, a Michigan non-profit corporation.
Minerals:	The seller will convey mineral rights.


