Starting at the park's Warming Shelter.

Special guided nature/history walk through the wooded sand dunes under the stars and moonlight on snowshoes. Snowshoes provided for those who need them. Ages 8 and up. Cost: Free. No reservations needed.

Winter Night Lantern Lit Trail Events

Saturdays, Dec. 9, Jan. 6 and 20, Feb. 3 and 17, Mar. 2. 6 p.m. to 8 p.m.

Starting at the park's Warming Shelter.

Walk, ski, or snowshoe one of the park's trails through the wooded sand dunes under the illumination of 75 lanterns. A warm campfire and free hot cocoa await you at the hike's end. Trail distance is a half-mile over easy terrain. Cost: Free. No reservations needed.

Cancellation of any of these events will be announced two hours prior to the scheduled start time. Cancellations may be made for poor weather conditions and/or safety concerns. Cancellations will be announced through the "Friends of Ludington State Park" Facebook page and website or will be announced on the Ludington State Park's answering machine (231) 843-2423 ext 1.
