Guided Snowshoe Hike

Saturday, Feb. 4, Feb. 11, Feb. 18 and Feb. 25, 2 to 3 p.m.

Strap on your snowshoes and join a park naturalist for a free guided hike through the forests of the Upper Falls. Learn about winter at the park and get some snowshoeing tips and tricks. The total distance of 1-mile is geared toward beginners, with a few hills and optional off-trail experiences. A limited number of snowshoes, including children sizes, are available to borrow on a first-come, first-served basis. No pre-registration required. Meet at the Upper Falls Fact Shack near the bonfire.

Lantern-lit Snowshoe Trail

Saturday, Feb. 4, Feb. 11, Feb. 18 and Feb. 25, 6 to 8:30 p.m.

Enjoy snowshoeing our 1-mile trail lit by over 70 kerosene lanterns every Saturday in February. Trailhead is located near the Upper Falls restroom building. Cross country skiers are welcome, but no track will be set. Warm up with complimentary refreshments by the bonfire between laps. Snowshoes available to borrow on a first-come, first-served basis. Well-behaved dogs welcome on a leash.
