We are again providing you an update of the Tribunal's activity. We are very pleased with the interest and participation in our ListServe. We have almost 500 subscribers as of this mailing, and receive more on a daily basis.

The Tribunal has updated its Web page to provide locations for most Small Claims hearing sites. Remember, however, the location for a specific hearing may be different and the parties should always consult the hearing notice and appear at the location listed there. The parties may also call the County Equalization Department for specific directions or visit Mapquest.com for driving directions.

Also, the Tribunal's Web page now provides parties with the ability to view their Docket Card online. This service provides an up-to-date listing of docket information for each case, which will allow the parties and the general public to determine the status of individual cases pending at the Tribunal. The listing is updated at the close of business each day to reflect the actions taken by the Tribunal during that business day.
