Tribunal members will discuss the proposed rewrite at a meeting of the State Bar Association's State and Local Tax Section on August 4, 2004, at 3:30 pm at the law offices of Dickinson Wright, PLLC, 215 S. Washington Square, Suite 200, Lansing, Michigan. The meeting will be conducted by web-cam from the Dickinson Wright offices and available for viewing at other sites. We are also issuing two new *Tribunal Notices*. The two notices address the filing of witness and exhibit lists and court reporter notification and the conducting of show cause hearings for a party's failure to file the required lists and notification, and the adjournment of prehearing conferences and valuation disclosure filing and exchange dates.
