WHEN and WHERE:

FEES:

The tuition for *Art in Motion* is \$585, which includes most materials, lunch, and a compilation tape of all work produced. University credit (3 hours) is offered through Central Michigan University for an additional fee paid to CMU. Overnight accommodations in dorms are available for an additional \$100, which includes breakfast (dinner is on your own).
