MIOSHA STAFFING LEVELS

Section 326 of the FY '03 CIS appropriation bill, P.A. 527 of 2002, states that by February 15, 2003, the department shall submit a report of staffing levels within occupational safety and health for general industry safety inspectors, construction industry safety inspectors and industrial hygienist.

As of September 30, 2002, enforcement staffing levels were:
