

Cornerstone University Advanced Placement (AP)

Students may be awarded advanced placement or college credit on the basis of examination. The amount of credit and level of placement are determined by the recommendations of ACE that have been approved by the Cornerstone University Education Policy Committee. Test scores of 3 permits a waiver of the course while scores of 4 or 5 are necessary for awarding credit. No charge will be assessed for the processing of credits by exam. Earning credit by exam will not be allowed for courses previously waived to allow enrollment in an advanced course. Credit will not be granted for both exams that have the same equivalents (i.e. Calculus AB & BC).
